Your order will be placed in the same order we receive it. Whoever leaves the first message about an item, will be entitled to it. Leaving the message will secure the order for you.

Orders are always made using the description numbers. In the event there is a discrepancy between the photo number and the description numbers, please use the description number.

Folding knives are measured in the closed position, except antique automatic knives which are measured open.

Should you want to return an item, please notify us immediately that it is being returned so that we can immediately contact the second caller

that it will be available.

ABBREVIATION OF TERMS

PRISTINE – Mint. In addition, it sells itself in a powerful way.

MINT – The same as it was when it was produced. May have a minor crack, or a freckle, but absolutely no evidence of use or sharpening.

NM – Nearly mint. Any deviation from mint is minor. If the item has been expertly cleaned, it must appear as mint.

EX+++ - Excellent condition. Only slight wear or discoloration.

VG – Very good condition. May show up to 10% wear. Blades are original, but may not snap, handles are original but may show damage.

- 1. JOSEPH RODGERS & SONS, SHEFFIELD, NO. 6 NORFOLK ST. CUTLERS TO HER MAJESTY PUBLISHED PEARL & SILVER EXHIBITION SPORTS KNIFE c. 1840-1880'S, 4 3/8" KNIFE, 13 blades and 3 slide outs. Master, flat spear, marked "JOSEPH RODGERS & SONS," wiscrewdriver, corkscrew, bartender's blade (champagne bottle opener), triangular leather punch, horse hoof pick some light tarnish on the tool back, awl, manicure, pen, sail needle, fish scaler-hook remover, button hook, cigar fork. Ricasso's are marked "NO. 6 NORFOLK ST." & "RODGERS CUTLERS TO HER MAJESTY" & "NO. 6 NORFOLK ST. SHEFFIELD" & "STAR & MALTESE CROSS." Engraved top silver bolsters, engraved silver shoulders at the base of the hoof pick. Perfect, thick pearl scales, over milled ns liners, fastened with Yorkshire rose silver rivets, with silver Federal type shield on the front and oval silver shield on the back. Slide outs include a pricker, tweezers and folding lancet. This magnificent beauty is found on p. 36-37 of Sheffield Exhibition Knives. Joseph Rodgers was the premier Sheffield maker, the most sought after of all makers in Sheffield. The Rodgers firm held appointments to six British sovereigns, including Queen Victoria from 1837-1901. This knife is pictured on p. 36 and 37 of Sheffield Exhibition Knives. From the Brad Watts collection.

UPSCALE GORGEOUS TURNED IVORY & GILDED FULL GUARD ENGRAVED NAVAL DIRK, c. 1800-1840'S. 9 1/8" KNIFE, 5" double edge dagger blade, sharpened both sides, median ridge, fully engraved on both sides, no evidence of sharpening and use. A few spots of light patina. Full gold gilded wide brass guard, with gold gilded multi-grooved ferrule. Turned ivory handle, round bulbous pommel, graduated and grooved, very attractive no cracks or chips, round pommel. Tight fitting black leather sheath, fancy gold gilded throat, engraved button, engraved tip, a couple small spots of patina, but most of the gold remaining. Stunning! EX++ \$1,050.00

ENGLISH NAVAL DIRK WICARVED IVORY HANDLE & GILDED BRASS BIRD'S HEAD FLUTED GUARD. c. 1780-1824, 8 3/4" KNIFE, nearly 5" double edge dagger blade, sharpened both sides, median ridge, medium pitting/patina, appearing full, fully engraved with florals & cannons, mostly original, very fine patina. Full, round, fluted, gilded brass guard, bird's heads on each side. Thin round grooved gold gilded ferrule. Tapered, turned ivory handle. Couple very-very thin cracks. Grooved gold gilded pommel cap. Snug fitting brass sheath, gold gilded, heavily engraved, button intact.

Full silver quard, with forward curving scalloped edge. Attractive handle, swell center carved & ribbed ivory center, eased edges, silver ferrule and pommel, fluted and contoured. One very thin, non-distracting crack. Original silver sheath, button intact. Splendid!

Sewn leather sheath, tight fit, scalloped & multi-ribbed brass tip and throat, and center section, two hanging rings.

Round ribbed, carved, tapered multi-grooved turned ivory handle, several very thin cracks, carved and fluted domed ivory pommel, twisted & fluted brass pommel cap. Brass sheath, fluer d'ils & floral engraved, two hanging rings, inscribed "SALTER SWORD CUTLER & JEWELER TO H.R.H. THE DUKE OF SUSSEX 35 STRAND LONDON." Salter was a premier cutler in London, cutler to Vice Admiral Horatio Nelson & the Duke of Sussex. Prince Harry is now the Duke of Sussex.
- 8. SALVATORE PUDDU, ITALY CUSTOM SCARCE 3 LOCKBACK BLADE 24K GOLD ENGRAVED EXCEPTIONAL TORTOISE SHELL FOLDER c. PRESENT, 4 ½" KNIFE, master saber and hollow ground Wharndlife blade, also (2) similarly made "harpoon" shaped blades, all three being lock backs. Bright mirror polish on the blade. Maker's name "PUDDU" is written on the inside of the backspring. 24k gold gilded & fluted liners. Deeply engraved 416 stainless scales, 24k gold inlays, 24k gold pique pins, fancy gold-plated screws, engraved & enlarged bolsters, by V. Peli of Creative Art. Checkered tortoise shell scales. Very high-end maker who has won many awards. Several years waiting list!
- 9. ROBBINS DUDLÉY, WORCESTERŚHIRE, ENĞLAND, SCARCE KNUCKLE KNIFE & SHEATH, c. 1876-1928, 10 ¾" DAGGER, nearly 6" double edge blade, sharpened both sides, median ridge, uniform gray patina/fine pitting, full or about full. Cast aluminum alloy handle, two double finger stalls (rather than a full knuckle bow) marked on the side "ROBBINS DUBLEY." A similar knife is pictured on p. 26 of Ron Flook's fine "BRITISH AND COMMONWEALTH MILITARY KNIVES." Original, sewn leather sheath, no markings.
- ROBBINS DUDLEY, WORCESTERSHIRE, ENGLAND, SCARCE PUSH DAGGER KNIFE & SHEATH, c. 1876-1928,7 %" DAGGER, nearly 6" double edge blade, sharpened on both sides, two fullers on each side, light to medium pitting, patina, full or about full. Cast aluminum alloy handle, three finger grooves, "wavy" steel knuckle bow, the base of the hilt marked "ROBBINS DUBLEY." A similar knife is pictured on p. 24 of Ron Flook's fine "BRITISH AND COMMONWEALTH MILITARY KNIVES." Original, sewn leather sheath, no markings, securing strap that wraps over the knuckle guard, one thin tear and light handling marks. EX++ \$945.00

RARE "RAM"S HEAD" GRIP PALM DAGGER & SHEATH. c. 1876-1928. 6 3/8" DAGGER, 3 ½" double edge blade, sharpened on both sides, flattened median ridge, eased edges, some original polish, gray patina/fine pitting, full or about full. Cast aluminum alloy handle, "ram's head" shape, rounded pommel, two large finger grooves, for grasping the handle with the middle three fingers. The pommel is marked "ROBBINS DUDLEY." A similar knife is pictured on p. 25 of Ron Flook's fine "BRITISH AND COMMONWEALTH MILITARY KNIVES." The knife pictured in the book is in the collection of the Imperial War Museum and the only known example of this particular pattern "to date." Original, sewn leather sheath, no markings.
- 12. CASE XX, 5 X, 2 DOT, USA 6100 SS SERRATED SPLIT BONE MELON TESTER KNIFE, c. 2013,5 5/8" KNIFE, single 4 5/8" flat ground spear point blade, fully serrated, brightly polished. Ricasso marked "CASE XX, 5 X'S & 2 DOTS" & "USA 6100SS." Ns bolsters, top pinched, bottom round, center ns "cigar band" panel, two inserts of creamy bone scales, no cracks or chips, ns liners. Very nice. NM \$60.00

WAAGEMESSER 501 FISHERMAN KNIFE, c. 1950-60'S, 6" KNIFE, 3 %" flat ground clip blade, fluted spine, blade marked with numbers for weighing fish, ricasso marked "PUMA SOLINGEN GERMANY" & "STAINLESS PATENT NO. 922214." The latches on the back of the blade are suitable for descaling the fish. Leather lanyard attached. Blade with original polish. Plated handle, checkered sides, round "fish knocker" pommel. The counterweight, also serves as a convenient "fish Priest." No box or paperwork.

Lanyard drilled swollen pommel. Light handling marks on the gaff.

Yellow pyremite scales, no cracks or chips, marked in red "T29" with grooved sharpening stone shield. MINT \$85.00

Also, long blade, fish scaler-cap-lifter-hookremover, marked "STAINLESS STEEL." Ricasso's marked "KA-BARSTAINLESS" & "UNION CUT CO. OLEAN N.Y." Ns bolsters. Burnt stag scales, no cracks or chips, brass liners, with ns Schatt & Morgan shield. No box or paperwork. MINT \$165.00
- 20. CASE XX STAINLESS USA, 7 DOTS, CASE'S MĒTAL HANDLE FLY FISHING KNIFE, c. 1973, 4 1/8" KNIFE, master flat ground clip blade, pricker, scissors & file blade with hook remover. Short screwdriver at the front. Ricasso marked "CASE XX STAINLESS USA 7 DOTS." Ns bail. Ns scales, one side with ruler and the front marked "CASE'S FLYFISHING KNIFE."

- KA-BAR, STAINLESS, MULTI-BLADE (5) CHECKERED BLACK HANDLE FLY FISHERMAN KNIFE, c. 1923-1952, 4 ½" KNIFE, (4) blades and (1) slide outs. Master flat ground clip blade, scissors, cap-lifterfile blade-hook remover, marlin spike. Ricasso is marked "Kabar Stainless." Short screwdriver at the front. Slide out tweezers. Checkered black plastic scales, no cracks or chips, marked on the front "KA-BAR FLY FISHERMAN." Ns bail and liners
- 22. MANIAGO, ITALY, LARGE CUSTOM STAG STILETTO AUTOMATIC PICK LOCK KNIFE, c. 1980-2000, 15" KNIFE, 6 ¾" saber ground bayonet blade, 3/16" thick stock, bright mirror polish, pronounced false edge along the spine near the front, ricasso marked "INOX." Ns bolsters, top with pick lock pull tab, flared bottom. Beautiful narly popcorn stag scales, brass liners, no cracks or chips. Ns round button lock on the front w/sliding safety. Super strong snaps! A big beauty!
- 23. LATAMA, MADE IN ITALY, BAYONET BLADE YELLOW & GREEN HORN PICK LOCK AUTO, c. 1950'S, 13" KNIFE, 6 double edge bayonet blade, saber and hollow ground, pronounced median ridge, some light sharpening, light blade loss, ricasso marked "LATAMA MADE IN ITALY." Ns bolsters, top bowtie, pick lock tab, flared pommel. Green and yellow horn scales, brass liners, press button, sliding safety. EX+ \$595.00
- 24. LATAMA, ITALY, PAT. 35958, KRIS BLADE YELLOW & GREEN HORN PICK LOCK AUTO, c. 1950'S, 11" KNIFE, 5" double edge, kris blade, sharpened one side, four (4) curves, median ridge, bright mirror polish, ricasso's marked "LATAMA ITALY" & "PATENT 35958." Blade appears full, some very light patina. Ns bolsters, top bowtie, pick lock tab, with flared pommel. Green and yellow horn scales, over brass liners, with press button on the front, sliding safety. Part of the horn scale on one side has separated a little, not distracting. EX++ \$495.00
- 5. HUBERTUŠ, SOLÍNGEN, GERMANY ANGLER SPRING HAMMER FISH KNIFE WIAUTO FISH SCALER & KNOCKER, c. PRESENT, 6 ½" KNIFE, nearly 4" flat ground ss clip blade, with nail nick, bright mirror polish, etched "HUBERTUS SOLINGEN ROSTFREI" on one side and "GERMANY" on the other side. Spring loaded fish hammer, serrated scale remover, bottle opener. Exotic wood scales, brass liners, ns top and bottom bolsters, ns bail & ns flipper, ss spring bar down the center. No box or paperwork. Comes with chain-link lanyard. MINT \$275.00
- 26. MANIAGO, ITALY UNMARKED HORN PICK LOCK AUTO, c. 1950's, 11" KNIFE, 5" saber ground bayonet style blade, pronounced false edge on the front, nearly 3/16" thick stock, no markings on the ricasso or the knife. Ns bolsters, top bowtie and bottom flared, pick lock bolster. Attractive mottled black and cream-colored horn scales, no cracks, some small bug bites near the press button. Sliding lock. Operates well. MINT \$275.00
- 27. ARMANDO BELTRAME, MANIAGO, ITALY STAG SWIVEL LOCK AUTO, c. PRESENT, 11" KNIFE, 4 %" saber ground spear point blade, ricasso marked "AB ITALY" on the front and "F/L" on the back. Ns bolsters, top bowtie and bottom flared, swivel lock bolster. Pretty stag scales, brass liners, no cracks or chips, round press button and sliding lock. Operates well, tight blade, ferocious snaps. MINT \$145.00
- 28. PORTUGAL, BLÄCK CHECKERED COMPOSITION ROCKER LOCK AUTO, c. 1970-2000, 8" KNIFE, 3 3/8" flat ground spear point blade, which has been lightly etched across both sides, ricasso marked "INOX PORTUGAL." Ns or ss bolsters, top bowtie and bottom flared, swivel lock bolster. Black textured front and back composition scales, brass liners. No cracks or chips. Press button and sliding lock. Works great. Scarce stamp from Portugal! NM \$145.00
- 29. MANIAGO, ITALY, CLASSIC MOTTLED BLACK & GREEN HORN PICKLOCK BAYONET BLADE STILETTO, c. 1950-56, 8" KNIFE, 3 3/8" saber ground bayonet shaped blade, pronounced false edge on the spine for about 1/3" of the blade, light blade loss, some light pitting/patina. Ricasso marked "MADE IN ITALY." Top bowtie ns bolsters, flared ns pommel. Mottled black and green horn scales, no cracks, chips or bug bites. Front press button w/sliding safety. Good snaps. Pick lock tab front bolster.

- 0. NEW YORK KNIFE CO. WALDEN, HAMMER BRAND, ETCHED PEARL "ORANGE BLOSSOM" GUNSTOCK LOBSTER POCKET KNIFE, c. 1882-1903, 3 3/8" KNIFE, master flat ground spearpoint blade, pen and manicure with knife point. Master etched "ORANGE BLOSSOM." The blades are tight, good snaps, some patina/pitting, master a little less than full. Ricasso's are marked "NEW YORK KNIFE CO. WALDEN" & "HAMMER BRAND" with arm and hammer. No bolsters. Pearl scales, no cracks or chips, milled ns liners. This pattern is one of the most appealing and collectible of lobsters. This lobster is called the "orange blossom" named by Tom Bradley, Jr. of the New York Knife Company in honor of his Civil War regiment, the 124th New York Volunteer Infantry known as the Orange Blossom Regiment. In the 1920-30's a pearl handled orange blossom was one of the most expensive pocketknives a person could buy. It brought 3 times, what a large trapper with a bullet shield would bring.
- WADE & BUTCHER, SHEFFIELD, ENGLAND, ARROW & CROSS, PEARL "ORANGE BLOSSOM" GUNSTOCK LOBSTER POCKET KNIFE, c. 1890-1940'S, 3 ½" KNIFE, master flat ground spearpoint blade, pen and manicure w/knife point. Blades are tight, good snaps. Ricasso marked "WADE & BUTCHERS, SHEFFIELD, ENGLAND" & "ARROW & CROSS." No bolsters. Pearl scales, no cracks or chips, ns liners. (See #30 above for more info about orange blossom knives.)

- 32. NEW YORK KNIFE CO. The blade is nearly full, perhaps 1/8" short, some light scratches, no patina or pitting. Half ns guard. Dark coco bolo wood scales, over a fully exposed straight tang, with black fiber spacers on both sides, with bird's head shaped aluminum pommel, drilled for a lanyard. Original Western oak leaf sewn and riveted leather sheath, with keeper strap intact. This is one of the rarest knives made by Western, a very small number of these W-31 USMC Parachutist knives were made. They were never marked with the Western brand and only had one stamp on one ricasso "USMC." The sheaths have been the subject of debate as they have been found in a variety of sheaths, but the most common one is this floral design with the single stitch.

Full nearly ¼" thick steel guard. The blade is attractive, with uniform patina/pitting overall, not distracting. Round leather washer handle, six (6) deep grooves, rubber spacers next to the guard and the round lead, skull crusher, pommel. There are some small dents/dings in the handle. Super nice, glued leather sheath, good fit, which is not original. Leo Baker, from Chicago, a blacksmith for over 40 years, his knives were patented and he claimed that they could cut through steel and still hold an edge. Very scarce knife in any pattern.
